Lebanon Fire Dept. receives \$500 grant

The Smith County Community Foundation is pleased to announce the 2010 grant recipients from the Smith County Action Fund. The Lebanon Fire Department will receive \$500 to help with purchase of additional items for the local fire truck.

The Foundation received eight grant applications with requests totaling more than \$10,800.

Grants are awarded **once a year** through a competitive process.

Other grants were: Cardiac Rehabilitation at Smith County Memorial Hospital, \$500 to purchase digital physician scales; Kensington Community Store, \$500 to help repair controls on the refrigerated coolers; Gardner Wellness and Therapy Center, \$500 to provide funding a blood

pressure and oxygen **patient** monitoring machine; Smith County Memorial Hospital, \$300 to buy chairs for outpatient seating; Smith County Farmers' Market, \$200 to purchase new canopies for the market area; and Friends of the Arts, \$200 to support the annual Arts Festival.

This is the Foundation's second year giving grants.
